Welcome to Krooner park.

We would especially like to welcome the players, directors and supporters of today's visitors Fisher FC.

Our FA cup match away at Lydd was very disappointing as we set everything up for the players to execute a win. The wind conditions, the surface, the players, the formation everything was handed over to them, but unfortunately we did not get the result we desired so we were very disappointed to exit early, particularly now as they could potentially face Kingstonian in the next round if they are to succeed against Deal Town.

In our first league match over at Abby Rangers, we were slightly better, but missing a penalty and easy opportunities to win was hard to take. But a fine save from Jordi off the line keeps us from getting nothing again out of the match. So to take a point away from home against a side that finished in the top four last season is on reflection, a good point. A score draw would've been a truer result for both teams.

So now we go again in the league and another away trip, but this time to newly promoted Sandhurst Town, and yet another draw. The referee has made a decision for us to go down to 10 men which has really killed our momentum, and we now find ourselves holding for a draw rather than going for the win. In credit to Sandhurst, they played the home pitch much better than we did. It is not your usual 3G pitch you come across and they knew exactly how to play it with the bounce and the pace of the ball so we had to adapt, and I thought we did okay in places, and a cracking strike from Kingsley was a great way to start his league debut for us. We're still unbeaten in the league, two draws out of two. We just now need to convert draws into wins and hopefully see ourselves climb up the table. We have a very challenging FA vase game Saturday against Fisher which I know will be a competitive and physical game. It will be our first opportunity to also play at home and for some players to experience the Krooner Park pitch, so we would like to try and take advantage of our home pitch.

And then bank holiday Monday over at Fleet Town where we would hope to get our first win of the league, but we will not be able to relax. We will need to play as hard as we can to try and find our first win of the season. Enjoy the game, and get behind the lads.

Fisher FC

Formed : 2009 (current)

Home Ground : St Paul's Stadium

Last Season : 11th Southern Counties East Football League



Originally formed in 1908, the Fish have a chequered history, including highs of taking on Bristol City in the 1st round of the FA Cup in 1984, playing Conference Football and towards the end of Fisher Athletic, winning the London Senior Trophy. The final few years of the old Fisher Athletic turned sour as the ground was lost and finally, in 2009 (five years after moving in with Dulwich Hamlet), the club was wound up by the high court.

A week later, following a successful meeting, a supporter's trust was set up to take control of the club. Renamed Fisher FC and continuing to play at Dulwich's Champion Hill, the club entered the Kent League and finished their debut season in 13th under the guidance of Gary Lisney.

Various managers (including Billy Walton, Martin Ford and Steve Firkins) have come and gone in the last few seasons bringing varying levels of success to the club (the most notable success being reaching the Semi-Finals of the Kent League Cup under Billy Walton in 2013/14, eventually losing 6-4 on aggregate to Beckenham, who went on to win the competition).

In December 2014, former Beckenham assistant manager Dean Harrison (the mastermind behind Becks' 2014 League Cup and Kent Senior Trophy double crown) took the reins. He brought with him a host of new faces and achieved the main task of maintaining SCEFL status with four games to spare, with impressive performances against more established sides turning more than a few heads along the way.

The club returned home to Rotherhithe just in time for the start of the 2016/17 season, with Gary Abbott taking over following Harrison's surprise departure in the summer. Abbott struggled to get things going on the field and was relieved of managerial duties in November. The club moved quickly to bring Harrison back to the dugout for the survival fight.

Despite a valiant effort, the club were relegated to SCEFL Division 1, and finished third in 2017/18 season, and were awarded promotion by the FA Leagues Committee, so will once again compete in the SCEFL Premier Division for the 2018/19 season.

A superb first season back at Step 5 saw the Fish finish 3rd in the league, having sat at the top of the tree mid-season. The club also reached the Semi-Final of the SCEFL Challenge Cup, and the Quarter Final of the Kent Senior Trophy.

Another shock departure from Harrison has seen the majority of that squad picked off to move on. After a brief spell under the leadership of Allan Fenn at the beginning of the 2019/20 campaign, Ajay Ashanike took charge and steadied the ship before the Pandemic brought the season to a premature end.

A very short 2020/21 Season provided us with a run in the Emirates FA Cup that saw us beat Horsham YMCA, then Tooting & Mitcham via a dramatic tie settled on penalties to set up a trip to Cray Wanderers, which saw us lose 3-1.

With things finally back to normal, the 2021/22 Season saw us finish our SCEFL campaign in 13th place. While success didn't come on the pitch in the cups, we enjoyed a night to remember against Brentford's B team in the London Senior Cup. The Bees won 2-0 as we set a new record home attendance of 425.

The 2022/23 Season brought much in the way of cup success, including a record breaking run in the Emirates FA Cup, with the club reaching the Second Qualifying Round and taking National League South side Welling United to a replay before bowing out in front of a record St Paul's crowd of 573.

A 59 game season was brought to a close with the Final of the SCEFL Challenge Cup, which saw us fall to a narrow defeat against Hollands & Blair.

The 2023/24 Season brings fresh hope and several new faces as we look to build on last season's achievements under the guidance of Ajay Ashanike and his young coaching team.

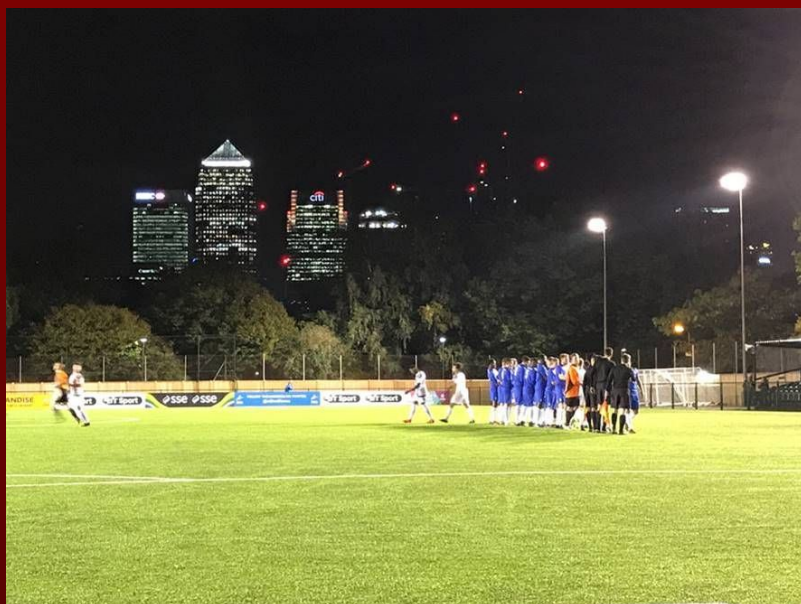

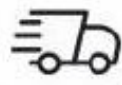
